

Scope of the Problem

- 1 in 4 girls & 1 in 6 boys are sexually abused
- With 30 million athletes, there could be as many as 7.5 million athlete victims
- 80% of abuse goes unreported
- Increasing litigation
- Increasing state legislation

Preventing False Allegations

False allegations are extremely rare!

- 1. Follow the policies.
- 2. Keep your boundaries clear.
- 3. Avoid time alone with a lone swimmer.
- 4. Treat all swimmers equally.
- 5. Don't pick favorites.
- 6. Respond directly to anything unusual and tell your supervisor and your Board President.

















Responding to Boundary Violations

- 1. Interrupt.
- 2. Share your concerns.
- 3. Contact the Athlete Protections Officer.
- 4. Report anonymously.
- 5. For allegations of abuse, report to the proper authorities.

USA Swimming Action Plan

- 1. Create comprehensive guidelines addressing acceptable coach behavior.
- 2. Review the reporting system.
- 3. Revise the Code of Conduct.
- 4. Revise the background screening program.
- 5. Disseminate additional information about hiring.
- 6. Share coaching history records.
- 7. Educate athletes, parents, coaches and club leaders on this important issue.








