

Scope of the Problem

- 1 in 4 girls & 1 in 6 boys are sexually abused
- 10% of school children
- 300% increase in incidents of youth-toyouth abuse
- 80% of abuse goes unreported
- Increasing litigation
- Increasing state legislation

















5 Steps to Protecting Your Athletes

- 1. Implement policies that define boundaries.
- 2. Implement procedures for managing high-risk activities.
- 3. Train everyone.
- 4. Implement responding procedures.
- 5. Involve all levels of leadership.













Implementing Policies and Procedures

- 1. Code of Conduct Article 304
- 2. Athlete Protection Policies *Article 305*
- 3. Best Practice Guidelines













High Risk Activities

- One-on-one situations
- Bathrooms/showering
- Free times/transition times
- Transportation and trips
- Overnights













Training

1. All non-athlete members.

2. Parents.

3. Athletes.













Responding to Boundary Violations

- 1. Interrupt.
- 2. Share your concerns with the head coach, team manager, or Club Board President.
- 3. Contact the Director of Safe Sport.
- 4. Report anonymously or to Praesidium.
- 5. For allegations of abuse, report to the proper authorities.













Responding to Reports of Boundary Violations

- 1. Respond quickly.
- 2. Find out as much as you can about the situation.
- 3. Review your findings with Club management.
- 4. Based on what you find, take the necessary disciplinary action.
- 5. Document.
- 6. Decide who else needs to know about the situation.
- 7. Analyze what can be learned from the report.
- 8. For allegations of abuse, report to the proper authorities.
